

ABOUT the POOL and SPA

- See **IMPORTANT information on back.**
- **NO DIVING.** The pool is only 4 feet deep.
- **NO RUNNING** in the pool area.
- **NO GLASS** containers in the pool house.
- Children must be over 2 years of age and toilet trained to use the pool.
- No children under 14 are allowed in the hot tub.
- Shower before using the hot tub or swimming pool.
- Swimsuits or sky clad are the only approved attire for the hot tub and pool. (*Sky clad = without clothing.*)

IT'S THE LAW

- Underage consumption of alcohol is prohibited. NYS legal drinking age is 21.
- Illegal substances are not allowed. The police will be notified of anyone distributing illegal substances.
- Firearms, fireworks, firecrackers, or any explosives are prohibited by NYS Law.
- Chautauqua County Law prohibits smoking in any building on the premises.



CHILDREN

- Parent/legal guardians are responsible for the care, safety, and supervision of their children under 18 at all times.
- Guardians must submit a notarized letter signed by a parent upon registering. The letter must authorize the guardian to make medical decisions for the child.
- Guardians must be over 21.
- There is no child care on site. Do not leave children at Kids' Village unattended.
- No children under 14 are allowed in the hot tub.

USE OF OUR SWIMMING FACILITIES

The swimming facilities at Brushwood Folklore Center, LLC are **not** supervised by a lifeguard or other responsible person. In place of on-site supervision, this facility has established a series of safeguards to be followed by all guests.

We are required to notify you of these rules, to ensure that water rescue equipment is at the pool and that the swimming area is maintained in a sanitary manner. In the interest of your safety, we require all guests to read, understand and abide by the following rules.

Please read the safety rules located at the entrance and outlined in this brochure. If you have any questions, we will be happy to discuss them with you.

- **NEVER SWIM ALONE.** A minimum of two adults 18 years of age or older must be present whenever this swimming facility is in use, with at least one adult on the pool deck.
- **THERE IS NO SUBSTITUTE FOR ADEQUATE SUPERVISION.** Children under 16 years of age must be accompanied in the swimming facility by a parent or guardian, or similar adult responsible for their safety and behavior.
- **IN AN EMERGENCY, NOTIFY THE FACILITY OPERATOR AND CONTACT HELP IMMEDIATELY.** A free telephone is provided at this facility. Telephone numbers for the nearest emergency medical service are posted (911).
- Only use the facility during posted hours of operations
- Don't drink alcohol and swim.
- Injuries can be prevented and safety is everyone's responsibility. If you notice any problems with the water quality or the absence of safety equipment, please notify us at once.

YOUR SAFETY IS IMPORTANT TO US. HAVE A SAFE AND ENJOYABLE STAY. Signing the campground waiver on the back of the registration card indicates you have read this brochure. Only guests of this facility who have received and read this brochure may use the bathing area.

GUIDELINES

Brushwood Folklore Center, LLC welcomes you! Please enjoy your stay at the campground. These guidelines are designed to promote a safe and fun environment. The campground is clothing optional and we insist on a very high standard of behavior. There is zero tolerance for harassment of any kind. If you have any questions about our expectations, please do not hesitate to ask questions.

- Everyone must register upon arrival; completely fill out the registration form, read and sign the waiver.
- Those under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- **All sales are final; there are NO REFUNDS.**
- Drive vehicles slowly and carefully; **the speed limit is 5 MPH.**
- **NO DOGS** are allowed. Please keep your pets at home.
- All pool and hot tub rules posted in this flier must be obeyed.
- NO swimming in the ponds.
- All Federal and NYS Laws apply.
- Campground guidelines are subject to change without notice.

Brushwood Folklore Center, LLC is privately owned; camp at your own risk and follow all posted signs and rules. Anyone not adhering to these guidelines will be asked to leave. Brushwood assumes no responsibility for property loss or damage.

ENVIRONMENT

• PLEASE PACK GREEN!

- Trash: **Carry in – Carry out!**
- Dispose of refuse in proper container.
- DO NOT cut, uproot or destroy any plant or tree.
- DO NOT drive nails into trees.
- Conserve water whenever possible.
Some conservation techniques include:
 - Wash dishes in tubs or buckets at your site.
 - Turn water off and on while showering and brushing teeth
 - Washing of vehicles and campers is not permitted.



HELPFUL HINTS

- Dress in layers. Days can be hot and evenings cool. Pack rain gear no matter what the forecast.
- Use sunscreen and reapply often.
- Do not leave trash or food out at night. Raccoons and other animals may get into it.
- Be respectful of those around you.
- Do not walk through occupied campsites.



PHOTOGRAPHS

- Current technology makes it nearly impossible to police photography so it is the responsibility of the individual and community to do what is right.
- Only take photos with permission of those being photographed.
- Do not post photographs to social media without express permission of those included in the photograph.



CAMPFIRES

- **Use of chain saws is not allowed.**
- Do not cut trees on the property.
- Firewood is available for sale.
- Help us protect our trees; do not bring firewood on the property from outside source. (*Ash Borers threaten the forest.*)
- Campfires must be attended at all times. Fires should be kept small and manageable.
- Clear away grass from the fire area.
- Do not dig fire pits into the field. Do not make a ring of stones around your campfire!
- Fires should be extinguished before going to sleep or leaving the campsite.
- NO open flames or fires of any kind inside a building, pavilion, tent, or camper.



VEHICLES

- **Speed limit is 5 miles per hour.**
- Parking passes are required for all vehicles on site.
- Do not block roadways at any time.
- ATVs are not allowed.
- Golf carts are only allowed with permission for special circumstances. Golf carts require insurance and a valid campground permit. Golf cart operators must be at least 21 years old. Only two people are allowed per cart.
- All vehicles including bicycles must have lights to operate after dark.
- All vehicles must be in good working order.

CLOTHING-OPTIONAL ETIQUETTE

Sky clad = Without Clothing



- Some areas are not sky clad. Clothing must be worn at the top of the hill including at Registration, The Studio, Painted Trailer and Cookhouse.
- Always keep a towel handy and put it anywhere you sit. (Good hygiene)
- It is impolite to stare or "gawk" at other people who are unclothed. Please be polite
- Be respectful of everyone (sky clad or not).
- Refrain from any crude or lewd remarks about another person's body or appearance.
- No photography. Save your picture taking for when nobody else is around and/or ask permission if anyone else is going to be included in your photographs.
- There is **zero** tolerance for harassment of any kind.
